

In partnership with the Canadian Rockies Outdoor Learning Centre and with generous funding from the Wim and Nancy Pauw Foundation, CRPS is excited to offer to all Grade 10 students in the division, the Wim & Nancy Pauw Wilderness Experience which offers some unique, challenging and powerful experiences for all of our Grade 10 students. Thank you Wim & Nancy Pauw Foundation for their ongoing support for all CRPS students and for their dedication to supporting meaningful outdoor learning opportunities for our youth.

It is the expectation that all Grade 10 students participate in this program as part of their program of studies at their respective high schools. There is no cost to families for this program.






Family Resource Network
